## Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance

Chairman Blair called the meeting of the Ohio Lottery Commission to order at 12:00 p.m.

## **Approval of Meeting Minutes**

Chairman Blair requested approval of the minutes from the November 8, 2023, Commission meeting. Chairman Blair made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Commissioner Brady. The motion was affirmatively voted upon by the Commissioners present.

## Approval of two (2) Touch & Win EZPLAY® Touch & Win Game Themes

- Poseidon's Treasures

Chairman Blair moved to approve the two (2) Touch & Win EZPLAY® Touch & Win game themes, with Commissioner Szollosi offering a second to the Motion. The Motion was affirmatively voted upon by the Commissioners present.

## Resolution to Approve Video Lottery Terminal Game Themes

Chief Legal Counsel Charles LoPresti presented a Resolution to approve thirty-one (31) Video Lottery Terminal (VLT) game themes for inclusion in the video lottery game theme library. Chairman Blair moved to approve the Resolution, with Commissioner Rickel offering a second to the Motion. The motion was approved.

## Financial Report

Chief Fiscal Officer, Ed Slyman provided the Commission with a financial update for the month of November. Total sales from traditional lottery games for the month were \$344.9 million, which was \$52.3 million, or 13.2 % higher increase over last November.

Mr. Slyman reported that Scratch-Off game sales for the month were up approximately \$4.0 million, or 2.2.% higher than last year. Draw-based game sales for November were \$157.8 million, which was \$56.3 million or 26.3% lower than the same month last year. Pick Games were up \$3.6 million or 6.1% as well. Mr. Slyman also reported that Keno was all down \$1.7 million, or -1.4% vs last year.

Mr. Slyman reported that the multi-state game category, which includes Mega Millions, Powerball, and Lucky for Life, was down \$55.1M or -71% when compared to last year. This was primarily due to the fact that in November of 2022, there was a record Powerball jackpot of \$2.04 Billion that produced higher than anticipated sales during this time period.

Mr. Slyman also informed the Commission that Gross Gaming Revenue (GGR) from VLTs for the month was \$105.7 million, which was \$0.7 million less than last year. Lastly, Mr. Slyman reported the prize expense represented 64.3% of traditional sales.

## Executive Director's Report

Chairman Blair asked Director Gillcrist to give the Director's report. Director Gillcrist reported that the Lottery's transfer to the Lottery Profits Education Fund (LPEF) for the month of November was \$118.2 million. This transfer was \$3.3 million more than our budgeted commitment for the month and \$17.2 million less than last November.

Director Gillcrist reported that three Lottery employees recently graduated from the Governor's Leadership Academy. She indicated that the participating employees found this program beneficial, and the Lottery will submit additional employees participate in next year's training as well.

Director Gillcrist announced Cash Explosion is kicking off their Facing Hunger Campaign. During this time, Cash Explosion fans may donate money or food to the campaign for a chance to win Cash Explosion prizes. The Director invited Commissioners to record a promo message to be aired on the show, if desired.

Director Gillcrist then introduced Percy Turner, Deputy Director of General Services. Deputy

Director Turner introduced the members of his General Services team and provided an update on the operations of the department. Among other functions, the department oversees the licensing of retailers, assists with paper and bet card supplies for customers, and manages the fleet vehicles. Deputy Director Turner also recognized two retiring employees Bill Allen and Andrew Demjanczuk for their years of service and dedication to the Lottery.

## **ADJOURNMENT**

With no further business before the Ohio Lottery Commission, Chairman Blair informed Commissioners that the next meeting will be held on Wednesday, January 10, 2024, at 12:00 p.m. via teleconferencing and in person and adjourned the meeting.
